Mark Stiers, 47, is vice president of gas sales & supply at Michigan Consolidated Gas Company (MichCon), one of three major business units of DTE Energy (NYSE: DTE), a Detroit-based diversified energy company involved in the development and management of energy-related businesses and services nationwide. Stiers is responsible for the procurement and delivery of natural gas to the MichCon system for all its supply customers and the management and administration of the Gas Customer Choice program. He also is charged with leading the sales and marketing efforts in delivering gas and related services to all customers, from residential through large industrial, including the sale of wholesale storage and transportation services to large non-franchise customers. Stiers is also responsible for the efficient and effective operation of MichCon's transmission, storage and large volume distribution system, ensuring the proper controls and processes are in place while interfacing with external parties through gas nominations, measurement and control systems.

Prior to joining MichCon, Stiers was chief operating officer at Quest Energy, LLC, the largest alternative electricity supplier in Michigan, where he led operations and the delivery of electric products and services to commercial and industrial customers. At the same time, Stiers was vice president of retail electric at WPS Energy Services, the parent company of Quest Energy. In this position, Stiers was responsible for retail electricity activities in Ontario, Michigan, New York, Illinois, Ohio and the Northeast. Prior to his tenure with WPS Energy, Stiers served as senior vice president of Engage Energy, directing the development and delivery of structured energy products in the Midwest, Mid-Atlantic and Eastern Canadian markets.

Stiers earned a master of business administration and an honors bachelor of commerce degree from the University of Windsor.
