Meador, 52, is executive vice president and chief financial officer of DTE Energy (NYSE: DTE), a Detroit-based diversified energy company involved in the development and management of energy-related businesses and services nationwide. Additionally, he oversees the supply chain management facilities, fleet and warehousing functions.

Meador joined DTE Energy in 1997 as vice president and controller. In May 2001, the board of directors elected Meador to his current position. In addition to controller, Meador served as senior vice president and treasurer. Prior to joining DTE Energy, he served in a variety of financial and accounting positions at Chrysler Corp. for 14 years, and was an auditor with Coopers & Lybrand.

Meador earned a bachelor's degree in accounting and a master of business administration degree from Wayne State University. He is a Certified Public Accountant and member of the MACPA, AICPA, FEI and CFO Executive Board.

Meador was named 2008 CFO of the Year for Large Public Companies by Crain's Detroit Business. Active in leadership development, Meador was DTE Energy's representative as a founding member of the Society of Organizational Learning based in Cambridge, Mass. led by Peter Senge.
